
A ship tows sound producers to signal temporary sound receivers placed on seafloor.


TEMPORARY SOUND RECEIVERS

Acoustic waves from a sound source travel into layers of rock.



BETA Geophysical Survey over existing producing leases of the BETA oil field will not open up new territory for drilling.






As we gradually recover this known reserve, data from the geophysical survey will allow for maximum precision and the smallest possible operating footprint.
