### **OCS Study BOEMRE 2011-043 and 2011-044**

The Bureau of Ocean Energy Management (BOEM), Gulf of Mexico OCS Region, announces the availability of a new study report, *OCS-Related Infrastructure Fact Book: Volume I: Post-Hurricane Impact Assessment and Volume II: Communities in the Gulf of Mexico*.

The purpose of this research was to examine the wide range of energy infrastructure assets along the Gulf of Mexico that supports, or is supported by, offshore oil and gas production. The sectors and infrastructure examined include the following: platform fabrication yards; shipyards and shipbuilding yards; port facilities; support and transport facilities; waste management facilities; pipelines; pipecoating yards; liquefied natural gas facilities; natural gas processing facilities; natural gas storage facilities; refineries; petrochemical plants; and electric power infrastructure. For each of these sectors the report includes a basic description of the industry and the types of services provided; typical industry characteristics that includes an examination of the typical types of facilities, the geographical distribution of the firms and their location along the Gulf of Mexico, and identification of typical or leading firms in those particular sectors; and regulation of the industry, as well as future trends for each sector.
