

The boundaries of the regular blocks are 4,800 international meters on a side and contain 2,304 hectares. The regular boundaries are defined in terms of X and Y coordinates of the Universal Transverse Mercator Grid System based on the Geodetic Reference System (GRS) 1980 Ellipsoid.

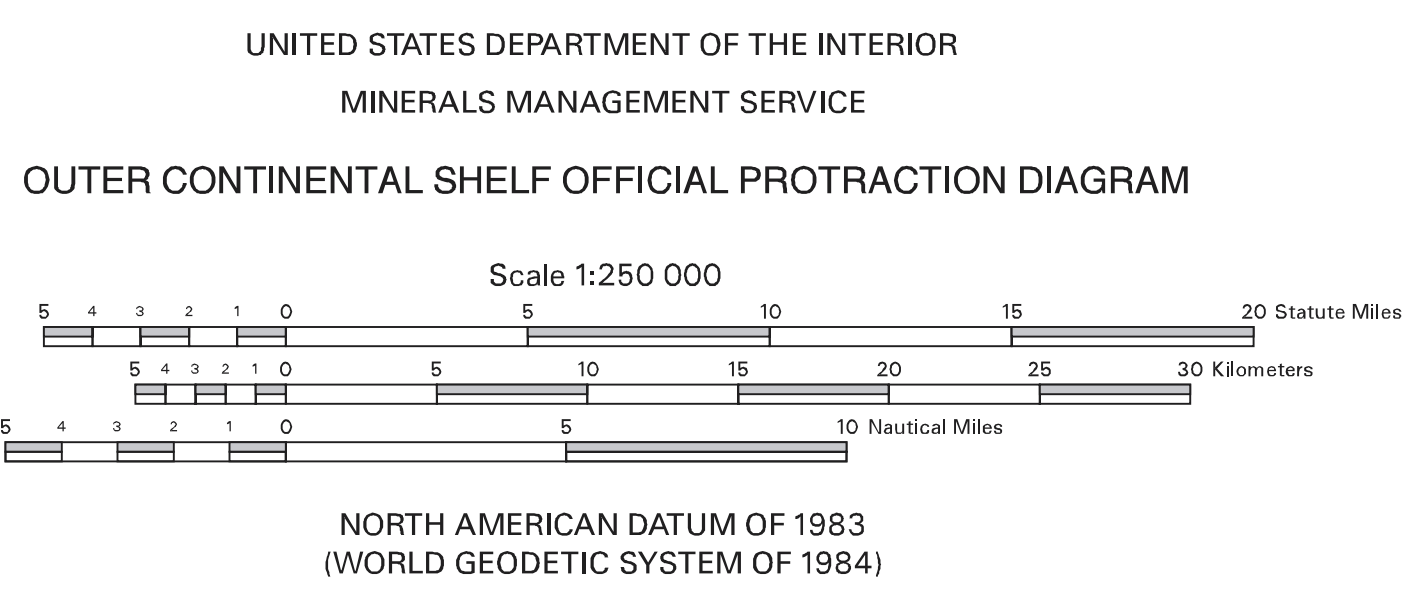
The areas of the fractional blocks abutting the Exclusive Economic Zone Limit and the U.S.-Cuba Provisional Maritime Boundary line have been determined and are as depicted on the Supplemental Official OCS Block Diagrams (SOBD's). Consult the SOBD's for official descriptions and approval dates.

The coordinate values appearing on this document were derived using NAD 83/WGS 84.

The United States - Cuba Maritime Boundary depicted here is provisional, pending the entry into force of applicable boundary delimitation agreements and, beyond 200 nautical miles, pending the establishment of United States continental shelf jurisdiction, if any.
