Environmental Review Process

- 1 Scoping (We Are Here)**

This is the first step in the environmental review process. We seek information related to the project area including issues to be addressed in our environmental assessment.

Everyone is invited to submit information. The formal public comment period will close on July 28, 2014
- 2 Preparation of Environmental Assessment**

Principle Power will gather and submit environmental information with their Construction and Operations Plan. BOEM will prepare an environmental assessment after the Construction and Operations plan has been submitted.

The initial environmental assessment will be published for public review and comment.

— This is Your Next Opportunity to Comment —
- 3 Environmental Assessment and Finding Published**

BOEM will publish the final environmental assessment and our findings. We may find that the project will have no significant impact, the project may be mitigated to have no significant impact, or that the project will require a more extensive environmental review.

This finding will be available for public review for 30 days before we make a final determination.
