Observations from underwater ground truthing of remote sensing targets in the Paleo-Suwannee and Paleo-Aucilla drainages are discussed and include attempts to date organic basal sediments. Important information from novel application of remote sensing devices is also mentioned within the broader interest of locating important loci on the now submerged Inner Continental Shelf.
