On or about March 17, 2022, U.S. District Court Judge Greg Guidry of the Eastern District of Louisiana approved a consent decree entered into by Taylor and the United States, among other parties to address civil claims arising from the MC 20 Incident ("Consent Decree"). Pursuant to the Consent Decree, Taylor was obligated to make certain payments to the United States. We now write to request documentation related to compliance with the Consent Decree. Pursuant to the Freedom of Information Act ("FOIA"), we request that you furnish this office a copy of the following documents related to the resolution entered into by the Consent Decree: 1. A complete list of all payments made to the United States by or on behalf of Taylor pursuant to the Consent Decree. For each payment, this list should include: (a) the amount of the payment; (b) the date the transfer was initiated, (c) the date the transfer was received, and (d) the designation of the payment as required by the Consent Decree. 2. Proof of each payment included in the list requested in item (1). 3. Copy of the written notice(s) from Taylor to the United States indicating that each payment was made, as required by the Consent Decree. 4. Documents listing all outstanding payments required from or on behalf of Taylor pursuant to the Consent Decree. For each payment, the list should include the anticipated designation of the payment as required by the Consent Decree and the amount of the anticipated payment. 5. Documents reflecting a complete accounting of how each payment made by or on behalf of Taylor to the United States pursuant to the Consent Decree has been earmarked and/or spent.
