

All blocks are based on the Universal Transverse Mercator Grid System, Zone 17, with X origin = 1,640,416.67 feet (500,000 international meters) at 81° West Longitude, and Y origin = 0 feet at 0° Latitude.

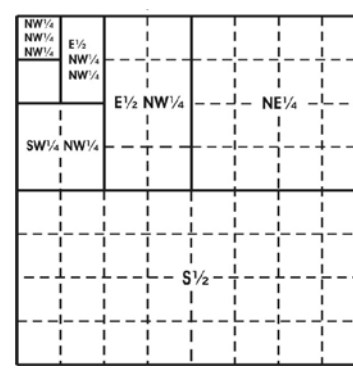
Regular blocks are 15,840 feet on a side and contain 5,760 acres.

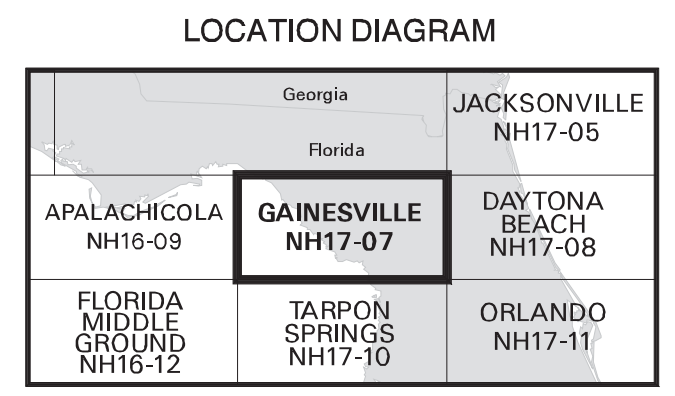
Subdivision of Blocks on the Outer Continental Shelf
