This map depicts Outer Continental Shelf (OCS) regions adjacent to U.S. coastal states in addition to areas adjacent to major and minor U.S. territories.

OCS regions illustrated in this map are delineated between the states' seaward boundaries and the extent of the U.S. Extended Continental Shelf (ECS) Limit or, as appropriate, to the extent of the U.S. Exclusive Economic Zone (EEZ) or are defined by Treaty boundaries.

Areas offshore U.S. territories were added to the OCS as specified in the Inflation Reduction Act (IRA) of 2022. The IRA limits the OCS acreage to within the exclusive economic zone offshore the U.S. territories.
