

The boundaries of the regular blocks are 4,800 international meters on a side and contain 2,304 hectares. The regular boundaries are defined in terms of X and Y coordinates of the Universal Transverse Mercator Grid System based on the Geodetic Reference System (GRS) 80 Ellipsoid.

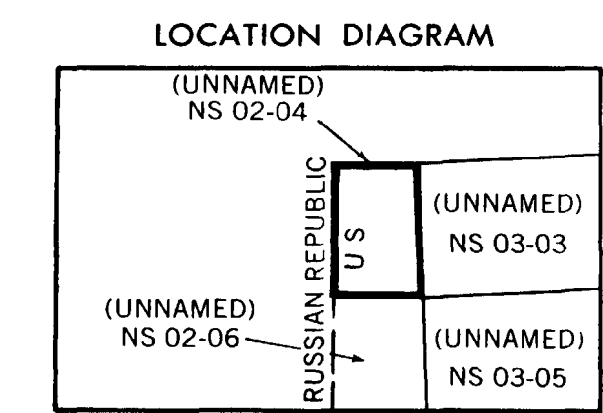
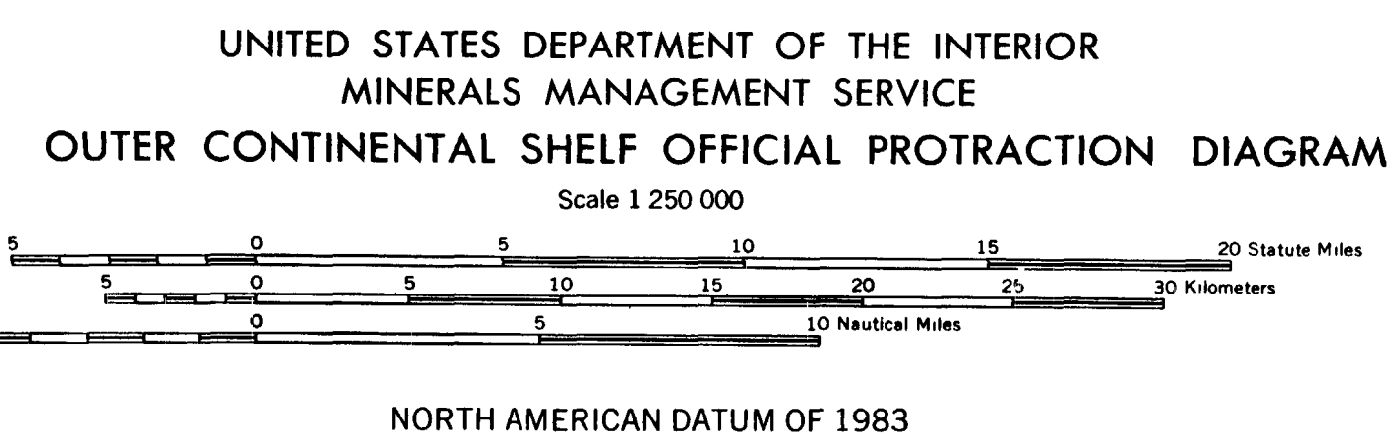
The United States-Russia Maritime Boundary depicted here is provisional, pending the entry into force of applicable boundary delimitation agreements and, beyond 200 nautical miles, pending the delimitation of United States continental shelf jurisdiction.

Although not shown, the 200 nautical mile Exclusive Economic Zone (EEZ) limit lies within this diagram.

The coordinate values appearing on this document were derived using the North American Datum of 1983.

The areas of the fractional blocks abutting the U.S.-Russia Provisional Maritime Boundary have been determined and are as depicted on the Supplemental Official Block Diagrams.
