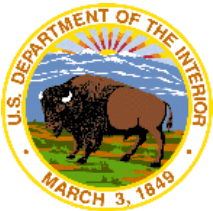
The purpose of a Request for Interest (RFI):

1. Provide a description of the proposed project and the requested lease area for the public to review
2. Provide interested parties opportunity to express interest in competing for an OCS lease
3. Parties other than those interested in competing for an OCS lease submit comments

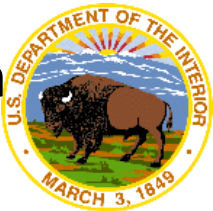


BOEM uses the information and comments received in response to an RFI to:

- Make a Determination of Competitive Interest
- Further identify and refine the proposed lease area(s)
- Develop options for environmental analysis
- Solicit public input on potential environmental consequences
- Prepare for future National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) analysis
