




Delaware Energy Solutions Act

- Authorizes the State Energy Office to procure up to 1,200 megawatts of electricity to Delaware's public utilities;
- Authorizes the State Energy Office, in consultation with the Delaware Public Service Commission and the Delaware Renewable Energy Task Force to craft a solicitation for offshore wind;
- Lays out guidelines for lease terms, pricing, potential impacts to transmission system, economic costs and benefits and other considerations.

Collaborating early and often when:


- identifying potential procurement projects and
