The BOEM Central Atlantic Intergovernmental Renewable Energy Task Force is composed of Federal, Tribal, state and local government officials from North Carolina, Virginia, Maryland, Delaware and New Jersey. It is tasked with facilitating the coordination of renewable energy planning activities on the Outer Continental Shelf in the Central Atlantic region. It serves as a forum to discuss issues and concerns; exchange data and information about ocean resources and uses; and facilitate early and continual dialogue and collaboration opportunities.

## **Meeting Purpose and Objectives:**

- Facilitate coordination, consultation, and information sharing among Federal, Tribal, state, and local governments regarding BOEM's commercial offshore wind energy planning activities in the Central Atlantic region ahead of a possible second Central Atlantic lease auction (hereafter referred to as 'Central Atlantic 2).
- Receive updates from other Task Force members, including individual states, various federal agencies, and Tribal governments.
- Receive feedback on the Central Atlantic 2 leasing process:
  - Call for Information and Nominations
  - Additional information BOEM is reviewing as it prepares to identify draft Wind Energy Areas, including previous feedback from the first round of Central Atlantic lease planning
- Discuss next steps, including:
  - Central Atlantic 2 timeline
  - Planned outreach and engagement activities
